Room in the Inn 2019-2020

Opportunities to Help

We have a current need for many volunteers for the upcoming Room in the Inn season. We need help from interested volunteers who can fill the following roles:

•Overnight Hosts -- We need 2-3 SJBC members to serve as overnight hosts on each of the Friday nights that St. John's hosts 12 homeless men during Room in the Inn season which runs from December 1st through March 31. Our overnight hosts would serve from about 5PM Friday evening until 7AM Saturday.

•Van Drivers -- We need van drivers to drive the church van each of the 17 Friday nights and Saturday mornings of the RITI season. A van driver drives the church van from the church to Urban Ministry Center at 4:45PM on Friday to pick up 12 homeless men assigned to St. John's. The next morning, our van driver returns to the church at 7AM to take the men to the Transit Center. No special driver's license is required.

•Bag Lunch Providers -- On Friday, volunteers deliver 12 bag lunches to the lounge kitchen by 5:30PM.

•Setup Team Members -- Each Friday at 4PM, a two-person setup team helps in configuring the gym as a sleeping area for our 12 guests.

•Meal Provider -- Each Friday evening, meal providers deliver and serve dinner for our 12 guests. We also ask the meal provider to provide portable breakfast foods such as muffins, biscuits, and fruit for the following morning.

•Laundry Assistant -- Each Friday, we need a volunteer to wash RITI laundry (towels and bed linens) either at their own location or using the church washer and dryer.

•Community Resource Table Volunteer -- Each Friday after dinner, an SJBC member will present a 3minute video which describes job placement services offered by agencies working with Urban Ministry Center. The volunteer distributes the brochures and collects names of our guests who would like more information.


