Global Mission Offering Update

- Inspired by teaching under a tree on his first visit home, Lubo dreamed of a permanent primary school in Nyarweng. With St. John's mentor Phillips Bragg and Patricia Shafer of the nonprofit Mothering Across Continents, the "Raising South Sudan" campaign was born.
- Results so far
 - Two primary schools (Nyarweng & Gumriak) now educate 1,000+ children each year and routinely place in the top five for exam performance in their counties.
 - Teacher dorms, solar wells, and a feeding program were added; the third campus in Aliap is slated to open in 2025.
 - Annual operating cost ≈ \$200,000 (≈ \$250 per student); graduates from the first cohort returned in 2024 as tablet-equipped teaching fellows evidence that education is already "multiplying hope."

St. Johnsians, please let's keep this ministry strong at the Nyarweng School in South Sudan through generous giving by September 30! The children and teachers of Nyarweng need our support and Christ calls us to respond to their need and to be peacebuilders in the world.
